THE JUDGES DECISION IS FINAL

All competitors and spectators enter the showground at their own risk. No responsibility will be taken for loss, damage or injury to person, property or animals. The organisers of this show have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of all those present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers. All exhibitors/competitors compete at their own risk. Correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats Nos. PAS015 2011, VG1, (BS) EN1384 2023, ASTM F1163 2015 and 2023, SNELL E2016 and E2021, AS/NZS 3838 2006, MUST be worn by riders at all times when mounted. Hats should have a plain cover, either Black, Navy Blue, Brown, Grey or Green. Velvet covers are encouraged. The B.S.P.S. encourages members to have their hats tagged through the B.S.P.S. scheme or via the Pony Club Scheme. Tagging indicates that the hat meets the accepted standards, no check of the fit or condition of the hat is implied. It is considered to be the responsibility of the members/guardians to ensure the hat complies with the current standards and is tagged before they compete. Members/guardians are responsible for ensuring the manufacturer's guidelines with regard to fit and replacement are followed. Hat Tagging in B.S.P.S. classes is compulsory at BSPS Winter, Summer and Heritage Championship shows, Royal International Horse Show, London International Horse Show, Burghley Gold Cup and lead rein WSP final. (We are accepting British Eventing, British Riding Club and Pony Club tags). Body Protectors MUST be worn when jumping in any WHP and WH classes including practice ring at B.S.P.S. Affiliated shows. (Including Tiny Tots, Cradle and Nursery Stakes, WSP, LRWSP and Training Stakes).

Health and safety: this show is run with due regard to health and safety. We request that all exhibitors and members of the public comply with any request, written or verbal, from show officials which pertain to these regulations in their own best interest. Any accident should be reported to a show official immediately.

PLEASE NOTE: ON NO ACCOUNT MUST HORSES OR PONIES BE LEFT TIED TO LORRIES/TRAILERS UNATTENDED.

BSPS "This show is affiliated the British Show Pony Society and all persons entering, competing or otherwise taking part in BSPS classes, whether or not members of the BSPS are subject to the constitution and rules of the BSPS including the disciplinary procedures and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the BSPS.

Any pony taking part in classes judged under BSPS rules will be liable to dope testing.

RIHS QUALIFIERS

This show is a qualifier for the 2024 RIHS. The highest placed pony (not already qualified) from the first three ponies in the open Nursery Stakes and open WHP classes will qualify.

Owners and riders must be BSPS members and the pony registered with the BSPS to compete in classes with qualification for RIHS and animals must be registered with the BSPS.

BSPS QUALIFIERS

This show is a qualifier for the 2024 BSPS Championship show to be held at Arena UK. The 1st and 2nd prize winners only in the following classes – Open nursery stakes, open 133,143,153 WHP classes will qualify.

1st, 2nd and 3rd prize winners in the following classes: Open Intermediate WH and Cradles Stakes will qualify.

MIXED HEIGHT CLASSES. The 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th placed ponies will qualify for the BSPS Championship show, provided the animal is registered in accordance with rules 21 and 26 and ridden by a BSPS member.

THE BSPS CHALLENGE

BSPS Rule 440 in the 2024 BSPS Rule and Show Handbook

This show is a qualifier for the B.S.P.S. Challenge. Animals must qualify for the Challenge by attending any B.S.P.S. affiliated show and competing in the appropriate class:- Cradle and Nursery Stakes, WHP, Intermediate WH and Open Heritage WHP classes. Ponies must not have qualified for the 2024 Horse of the Year Show. If a pony qualifies for the Horse of the Year Show it will forfeit its qualification for the Challenge.

THE BSPS "BINKS FAMILY" CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS

The 1st Prize winners in the following classes will qualify for The Binks Family Champion of Champions:- Open WHP, Open Intermediate WH and Open Heritage WHP Classes

THE BSPS "BINKS FAMILY" MINI WHP CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS

The 1st prize winners in the Open Cradle and Nursery Stakes will qualify for The Binks Family Mini WHP Champion of Champions.

BSPS BLUE RIBAND PONY OF THE YEAR This show is a qualifier for the BSPS Blue Riband Pony of the Year. The 1st and 2nd placed ponies in the open 133/143/153cm WHP and intermediate WH classes will qualify. Owners and riders must be BSPS members and the pony registered with the BSPS to compete in classes with Blue Riband Qualification.

BSPS Desert Orchid WHP Qualifier This show is a qualifier for the BSPS Desert Orchid WHP of the Year

The judges named in this schedule have accepted the invitation to judge, but the committee reserve the right to appoint a substitute for any judge unable to attend. Whilst every effort is made to avoid clashing, competitors must decide which class to compete in if this is unavoidable. Breaks may be taken at the discretion of the judges and committee.

Class 1 BSPS MIXED HEIGHT NOVICE WHP/INTERMEDIATE WH

Mare or Gelding 4 years old and over not exceeding 158cms. Riders must jump in the correct height section and be the correct age for the height of the animal they ride. Riders may ride more than one pony providing the animals are in a different height section. (see rule 37) Riders must declare if they are competing in the 153cms or the Intermediate section.

Class 2 BSPS MIXED HEIGHT OPEN WHP/INTERMEDIATE WH

Mare or gelding 4 years old and over not exceeding 158cms. Riders must jump in the correct height section and be the correct age for the height of the animal they ride. Riders may ride more than one pony providing the animals are in a different height section. (see rule 37) Riders must declare if they are competing in the 153cms or the Intermediate section.

JUDGES: Mr M Cooper & Mr D Dixon

Class 3 BSPS CRADLE STAKES

Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained not to have attained their 11th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 4 BSPS RIHS NURSERY STAKES

Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 133cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Mini championship: 1st and 2nd prize winners from classes 3 & 4 to compete.

Class 5 BSPS RIHS OPEN 133CM WORKING HUNTER PONY

Mare or Gelding 4 years or over not exceeding 133cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 6 BSPS RIHS OPEN 143CM WORKING HUNTER PONY

Mare or Gelding 4 years or over exceeding 133cms and not exceeding 143cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 17th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 7 BSPS RIHS OPEN 153CM WORKING HUNTER PONY

Mare or Gelding 4 years or over exceeding 143cms and not exceeding 153cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 20th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 8 BSPS RIHS OPEN INTERMEDIATE WORKING HUNTER

Mare or Gelding 4 years or over exceeding 148cms and not exceeding 158cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Championship: 1st and 2nd Prize winners from classes 5-8 to compete.

RING 2 – INDOOR (9am start)

Class 9 UNAFILLIATED HORSE/PONY

Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over. Rider any age.

May split if sufficient entries.

Class 10 BSPS MIXED NOVICE INTERMEDIATE SHOW RIDING TYPE/SHOW HUNTER

Mare or Gelding, 4 years old or over, exceeding 146cm but not exceeding 158cms. Riders not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 11 BSPS MIXED HEIGHT OPEN CHALLENGE INTERMEDIATE SRT/SH

Mare or Gelding, 4 years old or over exceeding 146cms but not exceeding 158cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 12 BSPS MIXED HEIGHT NOVICE SHOW HUNTER PONY

Mare or Gelding 4 years old or over, not exceeding 153cms. Riders MUST be the correct age for the height of the animal they ride.

Class 13 BSPS MIXED HEIGHT OPEN CHALLENGE SHOW HUNTER PONY

Mare or Gelding 4 years old or over, not exceeding 153cms. Riders MUST be the correct age for the height of the animal they ride.

Class 14 BSPS OPEN CHALLENGE LEAD REIN OF HUNTER TYPE

Mare or Gelding 4 years old or over, not exceeding 122cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. NOT A WINTER QUALIFYING CLASS.

Class 15 BSPS OPEN FIRST PONY OF SHOW PONY OR OF SHOW HUNTER PONY TYPE

Mare or Gelding 4 years old or over, not exceeding 122cms. Riders not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Snaffle bridles only. No cantering is allowed except for individual performances, ponies must leave the ring at the walk or trot. (See Rule 277)

Mini Championship: 1st and 2nd Prize winners from classes 14 & 15 to compete.

Class 16 BSPS MIXED HEIGHT NOVICE SHOW PONY

Mare or Gelding 4 years old or over, not exceeding 148cms. Riders must be the correct age for the height of the pony they ride.

Class 17 BSPS MIXED HEIGHT OPEN CHALLENGE SHOW PONY

Mare or Gelding 4 years old or over, not exceeding 148cms. Riders must be the correct age for the height of the pony they ride.

JUDGE: Mrs P Hollings

Class 18 WALK & TROT CLASS – for genuine novice combinations – show can include canter.

Class 19 BSPS LEADING REIN PONY

Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 8th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 20 BSPS FIRST RIDDEN PONY

Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Mini Championship: 1st and 2nd Prize winners from classes 19 & 20 to compete.

Class 21 BSPS HERITAGE MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND OPEN CHALLENGE LEAD REIN
Registered Pure Bred Mare or Gelding 4 yrs. old or over, not exceeding 122cms. Suitable to be ridden

by a rider not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 22 BSPS HERITAGE MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND OPEN CHALLENGE FIRST RIDDEN Registered Pure Bred Mare or Gelding 4 yrs. old or over, not exceeding 128cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Mini Championship: 1st and 2nd Prize winners from classes 22 & 23 to compete.

- Class 23 BSPS HERITAGE MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND NOVICE RIDDEN MIXED BREEDS Registered Pure Bred Ponies 4 years old or over. Riders any age.
- Class 24 BSPS HERITAGE MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND OPEN CHALLENGE RIDDEN MIXED BREEDS
 Registered Pure Bred Ponies 4 years old or over. Riders any age.
